- Share practice with colleagues in other agencies in your local area.
- Have the opportunity to feed your views, concerns and suggestions about the impact poor wellbeing can have on the safety of children and vulnerable adults in your district, and how you think agencies should work better together to improve safeguarding practice across Hertfordshire.
