

## Mentoring Service

On average a mentoring programme will take place over 12 sessions/one term, or up to a whole academic year (approx. 35 sessions). This is dependent upon the needs of the individual and can be reviewed by the mentor and pastoral team.

Individual mentoring programmes can be designed for each pupil and can focus on presenting issues such as: Transitions, Emotional Intelligence, Adolescence, Sexuality & Gender Identification, Family Relationships, Future Planning.

Sessions are delivered during term time only in school.

A suitable room will include a table and chairs and privacy from oversight. The room will need to remain consistent throughout the mentoring period, same day, and time for each pupil.

Each session last for approximately 45 minutes, depending on the individual.

Our Mentors can work with between 6 and 8 pupils per school day. This includes breaks, written notes & liaison with the pastoral team.

Written feedback is provided at the end of each term relating to the mentoring programme undertaken.
